## **Sandusky Schools “NO CHARGE” Policy**

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Welcome to the 2010-11 school year!

A “NO CHARGE” policy has been implemented for the new school year. This policy is in effect in all three buildings. The cashiers will tell your student when he/she comes through the lunch line how much money he/she has in his/her account. This will keep the student informed when he/she needs to deposit money. You may also go to the Zangle website and see your student’s account. Contact the principal’s office or the Superintendent’s office for this information.

If your child’s account is overdrawn, a note will be sent home immediately with the student. If the student’s account is overdrawn, the student will be offered a peanut butter and jelly sandwich, fresh fruit, and milk. The account will also be charged for this lunch.

Applications for free and reduced lunch will be sent home on the first day of school with your child. However, applications can be completed at any time throughout the school year.

A printout of your student’s activity for school meals may be requested at any time. Also, restrictions from purchasing extra items can be applied to your child’s account by calling Beverly LeGault, Director of Dining Services, at 810-648-5202.
